As of July 1, 2020, Florida law requires written consent for any “pelvic examination.” As part of a comprehensive skin examination, your physician may recommend examination of the skin and/or mucosal surfaces of your genitals.

FOR FEMALES: For the purposes of this Consent, a “pelvic examination” includes examination of the skin and/or mucosal surfaces of external “pelvic tissue” including but not limited to the vagina, labia, perineum, anus and buttocks with a health-care provider’s gloved hand or instrumentation. Internal pelvic and rectal examinations are **NOT** performed at Venice Avenue Dermatology.

FOR MALES: For the purposes of this Consent, a “pelvic examination” includes examination of the skin and/or mucosal surfaces of external “pelvic tissue” including but not limited to the penis, scrotum, perineum, anus and buttocks with a health-care provider’s gloved hand or instrumentation. Internal rectal or prostate examinations are **NOT** performed at Venice Avenue Dermatology.
